Weekend projects/ Vocational Projects	• Short term project opportunities through Alumni - Students relationship, where working Alumnus can get there elementary work done through students in campus on voluntary basis and in return students get hands on experience and better CV
Guest Lectures	• Voluntary Guest lectures by eminent Alumnus in leadership role be conducted on campus / off campus for knowledge sharing

Above activities shall be coordinated by Alumni-Student Connect Program Committee (ASCPC) consisting of upto 30 student members pursuing different courses from prefinal year and sophomore year
